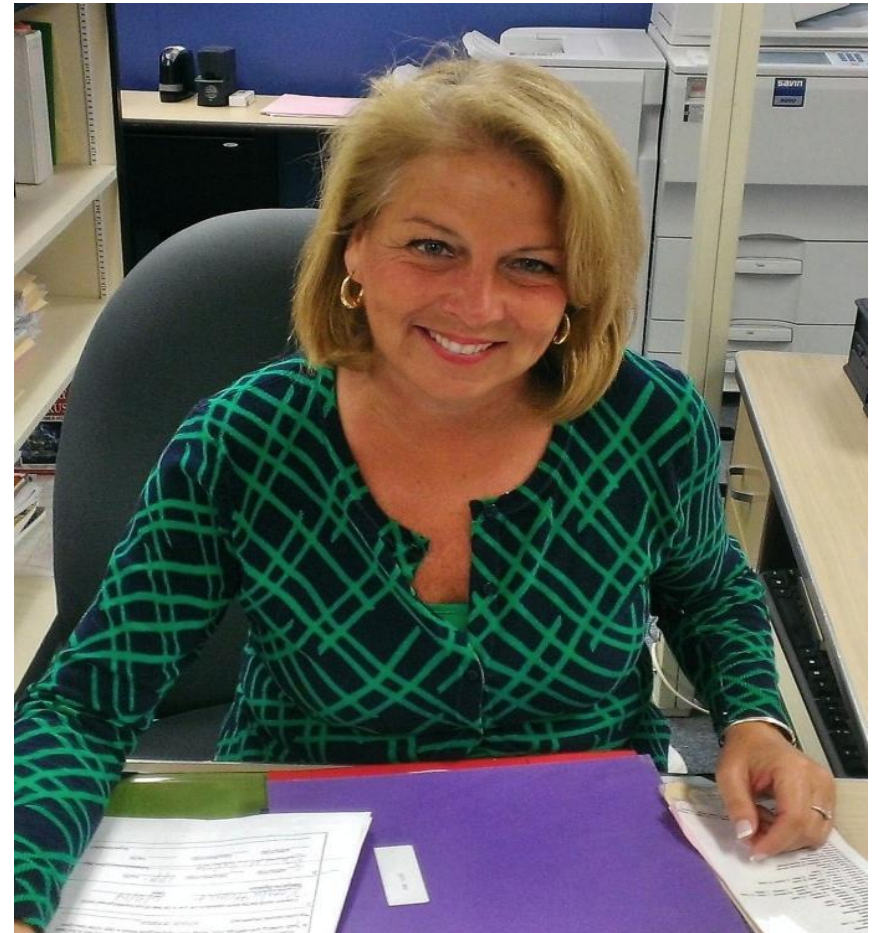

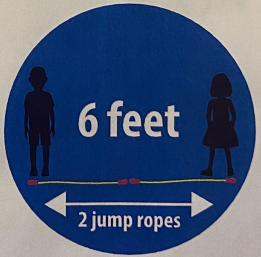

# Handwashing

Hand washing and hand sanitizing is a major prevention measure. Please work on proper hand washing with your children (washing at least 20 seconds with soap and water). Also please teach them to wash their hands after they use the restroom. We will have hand sanitizing stations throughout the building and will be reminding students to do this as well especially before they eat and after they come in from recess. Please teach your child/children the “proper way to sneeze or cough” and how to use tissues if they need to. Our nurses will be talking to students about these important habits but we need your help to introduce, reinforce, and set the expectation as well.

  - 3:16 PM: Follow traffic pattern at Parent Pick up





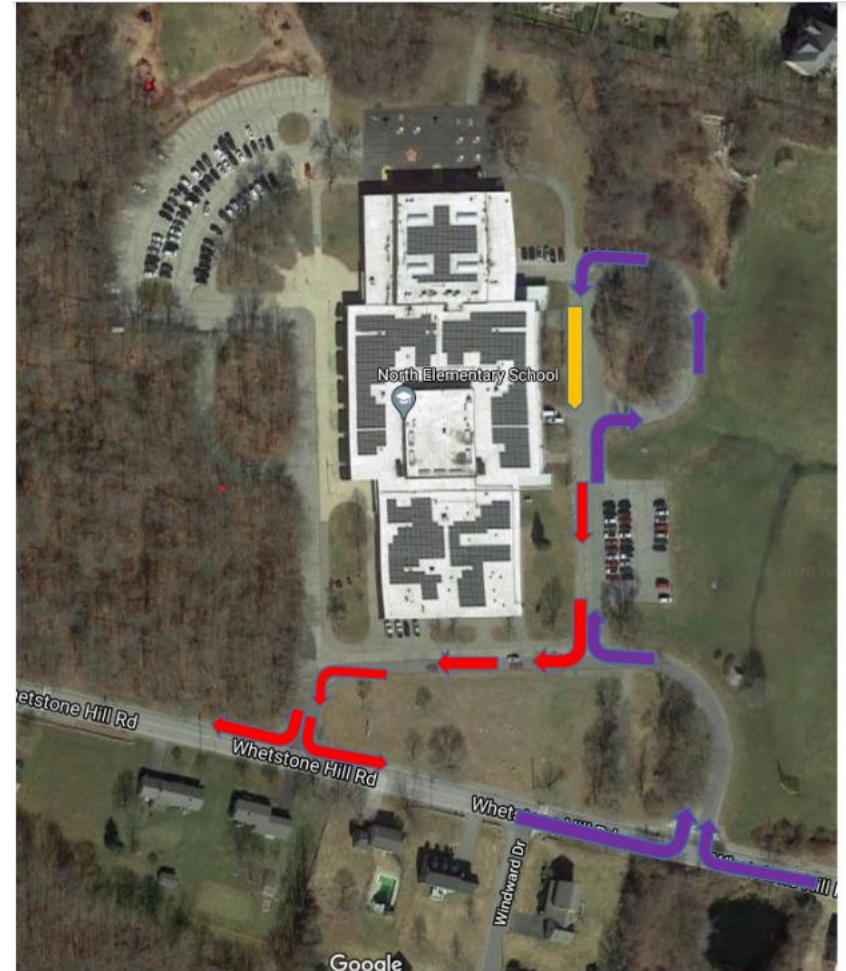
# Morning Arrival
